### RATE HIGH AT SAGINAW DEBATERS PLACE THIRD IN SVC OPENER; FLINT NORTHERN 1ST

Pontiac High began their 1953 Saginaw Valley debate season by placing third behind Flint Northern and Flint Central in the conference opener at Arthur Hill on Wednesday, November 11. Northern captured first place and Central by winning one more debate than the local speakers, second place.

Each of the six conference schools entered three affirmatives and three negative teams in a total of twelve debates. Results are determined on a win-loss basis. Four conference tournaments are held and final standings are based on the aggregate win-loss total to each school. This year all of the school teams seem very evenly matched but the teacher-judges seemed to show a preference for the affirmative side of the question. This was clearly shown in the second half of the tournament when the affirmative teams of all six schools won 11 debates while all of the negative teams won only four times. The question debated was "Resolved that the President of the United States should be elected by the direct vote of the American People."

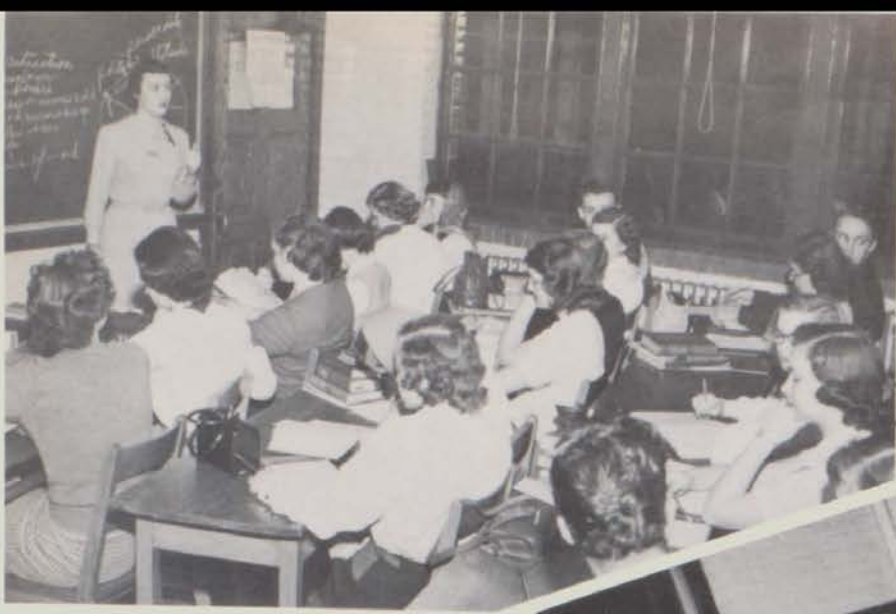
