CHIEF PONTIAC

The colorful and noble Indian warrior on the cover of this yearbook is Chief Pontiac, for whom our city was named. This same portrait was originally reproduced in oil by Jerry Farnsworth, an Academy of Arts pain'er, through pennies, nickels, and dimes collected by Pontiac students. The oil was presented by the city commission to the Pontiac Motor Division of General Motors Corporation in recognition of the firm's contributions to the city and its citizens. The 1956 Quiver is grateful to this same concern for making our cover possible.

A native of the Cleveland vicinity, Pontiac was born about 1720 and came into this section about 1750. He formed a confederation of Indian tribes that extended from the Appalachian Mountains to the Mississippi River and from Lake Superior to the Gulf of Mexico.

He favored the French and fought against the English whom he contended were taking the land away from the Indians without due compensation. During a good part of this time his war councils were held on Apple Island in Orchard Lake. There he laid the plans for his conspiracy to fall upon all garrisons in his domain on the same day so they could not help each other. This conspiracy is considered by historians to have been a masterpiece of strategy—which almost succeeded. Had it done so, it would have made a vast difference on the future history of his entire domain.


Early in May, 1763, was the date selected for the concerted attack. Of the sixteen garrisons in the territory, twelve were captured by his men. He had personally led the attack on Detroit, but Major Gladwin who was in charge there, had received an advance tip and was ready for the invaders and repulsed them,


His conspiracy failing, Pontiac's federation fell apart. He returned to Apple Island in disgrace, and a few years later went to Illinois where in 1769 he was murdered by a Cahokia Indian. His warriors who had followed him there were so loyal that they fell upon the tribe of his murderer and nearly exterminated it.

Pontiac, considered by most historians to have been the greatest Indian chief of all time, earned a reputation shared by few tribal leaders for his wisdom, strength, spirit, and honor. No stigma through the years has tarnished his shield of honor.




















